
Registration on WhatsOn - Multi-Stakeholder platform



WhatsOn is a secure space for the involvement of nongovernmental stakeholders, enabling networking, information sharing and interaction in order to foster partnership and amplify action of stakeholders against organised crime.

In June 2022, WhatsOn launched Phase II. From now on the stakeholders can independently register their organisations. In this guide we explain how the new registration process works.

Benefits of WhatsOn -Multi-Stakeholder platform






There are numerous benefits of becoming a registered member of WhatsOn platform:
